These choirs will be the Kent Theodore Roosevelt High School Choir, a choir from University School, Cleveland, and a 28-voice honor choir comprising students from Ashtabula County high schools."

Charles Edward McGuire, PhD, from Oberlin College & Conservatory, will present a pre-concert talk 45 minutes prior to each performance."

Ashtabula County 2026 High School Honors Choir brings 28 select singers representing Conneaut, Lakeside, Jefferson and Geneva Pymatuning Valley High School choral programs together to rehearse to perform together for Love in Bloom. Jefferson director Natalie Meloro and Conneaut director Austin Blair are co-chairing the experience with rehearsals hosted at Jefferson High School. The Cleveland Chamber Choir Artistic Dr. Gregory Ristow will guest conduct their preparation and performance which will include singing with the Cleveland Chamber Choir!

The Ashtabula County Choral Music Society Chorale, under the direction of Paul Shellhammer III, performs throughout the county in concert and for community events. They will also sing for and with the other Love in Bloom choirs.

In keeping with the CCC performance tradition to "give back", the **Grand River Conservation Campus** has been designated as the local "theme" partner. The GRCC is a place in Ashtabula County where people can enjoy nature through numerous passive recreation opportunities, all within a beautiful backdrop of unique habitats, rare plants and abundant wildlife. The nature described in the songs being sung is the same nature being offered in the reality of the Grand River Campus. Both groups, arts and nature, also share a commitment to learning and growing within community.
